BE A WONDERFUL HUMAN BEING:

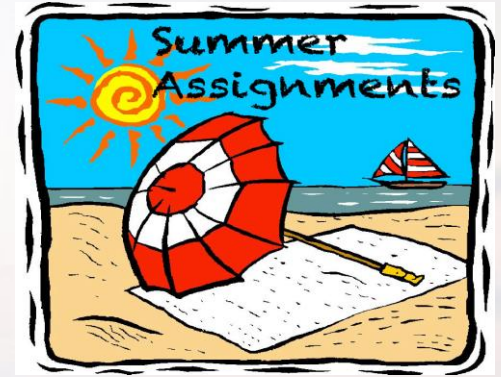
- Follow a schedule during holidays. Be a good time manager.

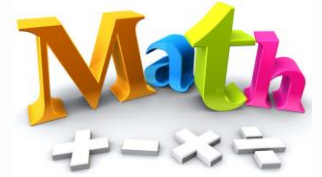

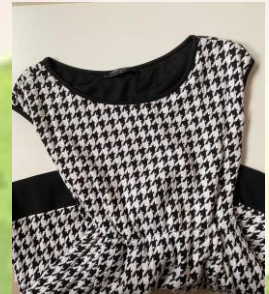
