GRADE X & XII ASSESSMENT PLAN 2024-25

Dear Parents,

As we enter the new academic session, it's vital to outline the Test and Assessment structure for Grades X & XII.

The assessment plan comprises two Periodic Tests, each worth 30 marks and lasting 70 minutes, scheduled in May and November. Additionally, Half-Yearly and two Pre-Boards of 80 marks, spanning 3 hours, will be conducted in September, December & January.

Alongside assessments, various skill-based activities including Subject Enrichment Activities, Art Integrated Activities, projects, interactive discussions, presentations, Holiday Homework, Practicals, VIVA, and notebook maintenance will be conducted.

The internal paper pattern will encompass a range of question types based on the CBSE pattern, including MCQs, True/False, Fill-ups, Match the Following, One Word, Odd One Out with Reason, Answer in One Word, One-Line Answers, Labelling Diagrams, Reason-Assertion Based Questions, Map Skills, Notices, Diagrams, Short Answer Questions, Formal/Informal Letter Writing, Application Writing, and Detailed Answers. These formats reflect the practice worksheets provided by the school.

Students will be assessed in both Scholastic and Co-Scholastic areas. Scholastic assessment will include Internal Assessment (20 marks) and External Assessment (80 marks). Periodic Assessment comprises Periodic Test (10 out of 30 marks) and Skill-based Education (10 marks).

CBSE PROJECT

Students will also be assigned CBSE Project Work by the end of September and are required to submit it in the first week of December before Pre-Board I. The Internal VIVA scheduled before Pre-Board I

will be conducted based on the project work submitted by the student.

CBSE INTERNAL WRITTEN ASSESSMENT (Grade X) & BOARD PRACTICALS/VIVA (Grade XII) of 20-30 marks will also be conducted in the month of January as per the Schedule provided by CBSE.
