Become a young farmer and grow your very own mini crop right at home.

Your Mission: Be a Mini Farmer!

What You'll Need:

- An old cup, mug, small pot, or a recycled plastic bottle
- Some soil
- ◆ Seeds Choose *one* from the list below:

Tomato

Methi (Fenugreek)

Dhania (Coriander)

Eggplants/Capsicum/lady finger

Onion/ Garlic

Steps to Grow Your Plant:

Fill your chosen container with soil.

Sprinkle seeds gently over the surface.

Cover with a light layer of soil.

Water carefully — just a little!

Place your container in a sunny spot.

Water daily in small amounts.

Watch your plant grow day by day!



Prepare 2–3 simple recipes using your harvested plant (or its parts).

Examples: Methi paratha, Coriander chutney, Tomato chutney, Any Salad containing Onion and garlic leaves

Take pictures while serving the dish to your family.

Take 2-3 photos of your plant as it grows.

♦ Label your plant container with your name and class.

Make Your Own Weather Forecast Objective:

Become a junior meteorologist! Observe, record, and report the weather like a real weather reporter. This activity will help you understand how weather data is collected and used to forecast the weather and understand climate patterns in different regions.

Instructions:

You are tasked with tracking your local weather for **7 consecutive days**. During this period, collect the following data daily:

Temperature (Maximum & Minimum in °C)
Rainfall (in mm or describe "No Rain" if dry)
Wind Speed (in km/h or use terms like Light, Moderate, Strong)
Wind Direction (e.g., North, South-East, etc.)

Part 1 Climate Graph Creation

Plot the data you collected on a **climate graph**.

X-axis: Days (Day 1 to Day 7)

Y-axis: Temperature (use a line graph) & Rainfall (use a bar graph

on the same chart)

Use different colors to distinguish between maximum temperature, minimum temperature, and rainfall.

Mention wind speed/direction in a table beside the graph.


Part 2: Comparative Study

Choose a city from a different climatic zone.

Use the internet or newspaper to find and record the same weather parameters for the same 10 days.

Create a Comparison chart, Pie Diagram, Venn diagram, Line Graph to highlight differences and similarities between the two regions.





Part 3: Creative Weather Bulletin

Imagine you are a TV weather reporter.

Prepare a weather bulletin (script or video) for your city.

Introduce yourself and the city.

Report the weather trends (e.g., "We saw rising temperatures midweek...")

Highlight any unusual weather (e.g., sudden rain, strong winds).

Include fun elements like graphics or props if making a video.

Materials to Use:

MS. POWERPOINT, CANVA or any other app.

Internet for comparison city data

Learning Outcome:

Through this project, you will:

Learn how to observe and analyze weather patterns.

Understand the impact of climate in different regions.

Develop skills in graphing, reporting, and comparative study.

Enhance communication and presentation abilities.

Bonus (Optional):

Interview a family member about how weather affects their day-to-day life or work. Suggest one way your community can prepare for extreme weather.

Math Survival Guide - DIY Handbook


Concept: Create your own Math shortcut guide.

- Agni (Fire) Prithvi (Earth)



To make a meaningful painting on 8 by 12 inches canvas board (A4 size) and a moral quote related to it on any one of the topic using the type of art paintings given below:


- AKASH: the sky is not the limit. (patachitra painting) (Roll no. 1-8)
