GRADES III-V ASSESSMENT PLAN 2026-27

Dear Parents,

As we embark on the new academic session, it is imperative to share the **Test and Assessment Structure for Grades III–V**.

The **assessment plan** comprises **three cycles of tests**, each of **40 marks** and **90 minutes duration**, scheduled tentatively in the months of **May, September/October, and December**.

In addition, there will be an **Annual Assessment of 60 marks**, with a duration of **2 hours 30 minutes**, to be conducted in the month of **March**.

Alongside these assessments, students will participate in a range of **skill-based and experiential learning activities** such as **Subject Enrichment Activities, Art Integrated Activities, Projects, Interactive Discussions, Presentations, Holiday Homework, and Notebook Maintenance**. These components will collectively carry **20 marks** throughout the academic session.

The **question paper pattern** will include a variety of formats such as **MCQs, True/False, Fill in the Blanks, Match the Following, One Word Answers, Odd One Out with Reason, One-Line Answers, Diagram Labelling, Reason–Assertion based questions, Case Study based questions, Comprehensions, Map Skills, Notices, Diagrams, Short Answers, and Detailed Answers**, etc. These formats are aligned with the **practice worksheets** regularly provided by the school.

To further support students and help them become familiar with the examination pattern, the school will also conduct a **Mock Test one week prior to the scheduled assessments**.

In line with the **New Education Policy (NEP)** and our commitment to creating a **supportive and stress-free learning environment**, students will receive **grades in their progress reports instead of marks**, and **no positions will be declared throughout the year**.

We look forward to working together to ensure the **holistic development and academic growth of our students.**
