GRADES VI-VIII ASSESSMENT PLAN 2026-27

Dear Parents,

As we begin the new academic session, it is important to share the **Test and Assessment Structure for Grades VI–VIII.**

The **assessment plan** includes **Periodic Tests**, each of **40 marks** with a **duration of 90 minutes**, scheduled in the months of **May and December.**

In addition, the school will conduct:

- **Half-Yearly Examination – 80 Marks | 3 Hours** (September/October)
- **Annual Examination – 80 Marks | 3 Hours** (March)

Along with the written examinations, **Science and Computer Practicals** will **also be conducted during both the Half-Yearly and Annual examinations**, along with the **Mock Tests**, to help students gain clarity regarding the assessment pattern and practical application of concepts.

Apart from written assessments, students will participate in **various skill-based learning activities**, carrying **10 marks each for the Half-Yearly and Annual terms.** These activities include **Subject Enrichment Activities, Art Integrated Activities, Projects, Interactive Discussions, Presentations, Holiday Homework, and Notebook Maintenance.**

The **question paper pattern** will follow the **CBSE format** and will include a variety of question types such as **MCQs, True/False, Fill in the Blanks, Match the Following, One Word Answers, Odd One Out with Reason, One-Line Answers, Diagram Labelling, Reason–Assertion based questions, Map Skills, Notices, Diagrams, Short Answer Questions, Formal/Informal Letter Writing, Application Writing, and Detailed Answers.** These formats reflect the **practice worksheets regularly provided by the school.**

To further support students and help them become familiar with the examination pattern, the school also conducts a **Mock Test one week prior to the scheduled assessments.**

The school will assess students in both **Scholastic and Co-Scholastic areas.**

Scholastic Assessment will include:

- **Periodic/Internal Assessment – 20 Marks**
 - Periodic Test: **10 Marks (out of 40)**
 - Skill-Based Education: **10 Marks**
- **External Assessment – 80 Marks**

In addition, as per **CBSE guidelines**, **Kaushal Bodh** has been introduced as a **mandatory project-based Skill Education Program for Classes VI–VIII** from the academic session **2025–26**. Aligned with the **National Education Policy (NEP 2020)**, this initiative promotes **hands-on learning and practical life skills** through **NCERT activity-based modules**.

Students will engage in **activity-based projects throughout the year**, encouraging **creativity, problem-solving, collaboration, and respect for the dignity of labour**. Assessment will be conducted through **portfolios, teacher observations, project work, and a year-end Skill Presentation**.

In line with the **New Education Policy (NEP)** and our commitment to fostering a **supportive and stress-free learning environment**, we request parents to ensure **regular attendance and active participation of their wards in all academic and skill-based activities**.

Let us work together to ensure the **holistic growth, confidence, and overall development of our students**.
