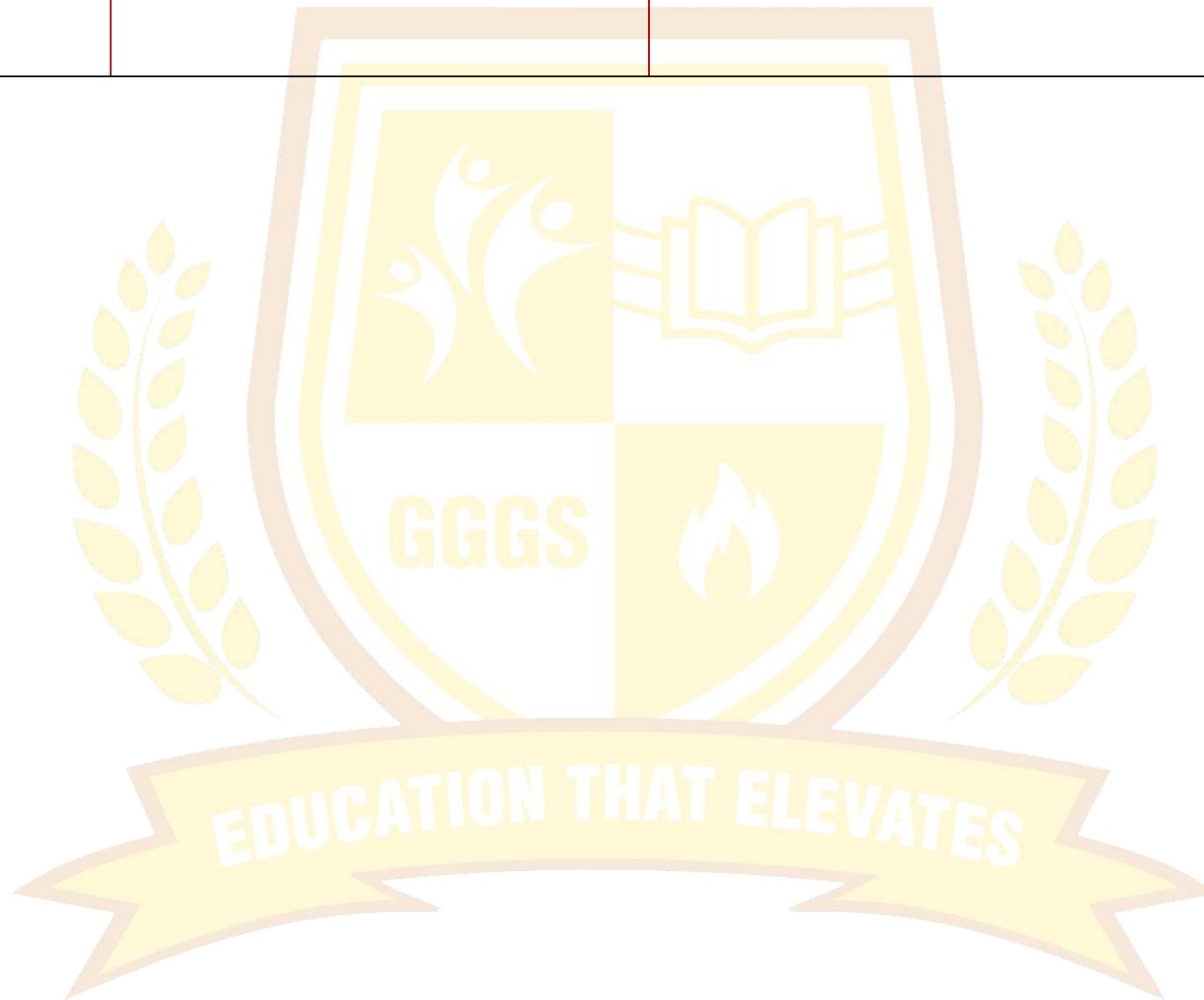

Apply basic formatting such as: - o Font style and size - o Bold/Italic/Underline where needed - o Proper line spacing and paragraph alignment 6. Avoid spelling and grammatical mistakes – use spell check if needed. 7. Make sure the document is well-organized and professionally presented. 8. Save the file properly and submit it as per instructions.
